



No. 3704 . . . Here is a new simplified version of the classic shrug, knitted all in one piece—dolman fashion. Directions are for both mother and daughter sizes. Equally attractive unadorned or trimmed with braid or beaded.

Mother and Daughter Shrug

Children's sizes 6-7 and 8-10
Women's sizes 12-14 and 16-18

Instructions are for children's sizes 6-7, changes for children's sizes 8-10, women's sizes 12-14 and 16-18 are in parentheses.

MATERIALS—Fleisher's Nylon 'n Wool*; or Fleisher's DeLuxe Sock and Sport Yarn*, 5 (6-7-8) ozs. "Boye" 14-inch Non-Inflammable Needles, 1 pair each Sizes 1 and 3.

For Trimming—1½ (1¾-2¼) yds. of braid or bead trimming.

MEASUREMENTS FOR BLOCKING—Width of back from cuff to cuff 31¾ (34-46-48) ins.

GAUGE: 8 sts = 1 inch 21 rows = 2 inches
Check, see page 35.

BACK—With size 1 needles, cast on 84 (96-104-120) sts for lower edge. Work k 1, p 1 ribbing for 12 rows.

With size 3 needles, working stockinette st inc. 1 st each side every 2nd row 16 (21-18-18) times; 116 (138-140-156) sts. Cast on 2 sts at end of each of next 14 (14-22-22) rows; 4 sts at end of each of next 20 (20-38-38) rows; 7 (5-8-8) sts at end of each of next 2 rows; 238 (256-352-368) sts. Work measures about 6¼ (7½-9½-9½) ins. above ribbing. Place marker at each side of work for beg. of sleeve edge. Work even until 3½ (3¾-4½-5) ins. above marker, end with k row.

Dividing row—P 104 (112-158-164) sts, place on holder for left side; p 30 (32-36-40) sts, place on holder for neck; p to end. Work 8 rows even, end with p row at cuff edge.

Neck Shaping—Inc. 1 st at end of next row and repeat inc. at neck edge every 2nd row 2 (2-3-3) times; every row 3 (3-5-5) times.

Cast on 9 (10-9-11) sts at end of next k row for front of neck; 119 (128-176-184) sts. Work even until 7 (7½-9-10) ins. above marker, end at sleeve edge.

Sleeve and Front Underarm Shaping—Bind off 7 (5-8-8) sts at beg. of next row. Bind off 4 sts at sleeve edge 10 (10-19-19) times; 2 sts 7 (7-11-11) times, end at front edge; 58 (69-70-78) sts.

(For Size 8-10 Only—Dec. 1 st at underarm edge every 2nd row 4 times, end at front edge; 65 sts.)

Front and Underarm Shaping—Dec. 1 st at underarm edge every 2nd row 16 (17-18-18) times, at the same time dec. 1 st at front edge at end of next k row and repeat dec. every 4th row 3 times; every 2nd row twice. Bind off 2 sts at beg. of rows worked from front edge 7 (8-9-9) times, end with a p row at underarm edge. Leave remaining 22 (26-28-36) sts on needle. Do not break yarn.

RIGHT FRONT BORDER—Beg. at underarm edge, with size 1 needle, k 22 (26-28-36) sts left on needle; pick up and k 22 (24-28-28) sts in the next 14 (16-18-18) bound-off sts, 18 sts in the next 18 rows, 42 (48-68-70) sts on front edge up to corner of neck—about 3 sts in every 4 rows; 104 (116-142-152) sts. Work k 1, p 1 ribbing for 11 rows. Bind off in ribbing.

LEFT SIDE—Take up 104 (112-158-164) sts from holder. Join yarn at neck edge. Work to correspond to right side, end with p row at front edge. Break yarn and leave remaining 22 (26-28-36) sts on needle.

LEFT FRONT BORDER—Join yarn at left front neck edge, with size 1 needles, pick up sts and work to correspond to right border.

NECK RIBBING—Join yarn on right neck edge in last cast-on sts at inner edge of front border. With size 1 needles, pick up and k 9 (10-9-11) sts in cast-on sts, 17 (17-21-20) sts on side neck edge; take up and k 30 (32-36-40) sts of back neck, pick up and k 26 (27-30-31) sts on left side; 82 (86-96-102) sts. Work k 1, p 1 ribbing increasing 1 st each side of next row and repeat incs. every 2nd row 5 times with care to work added sts in ribbing; 94 (98-108-114) sts. Bind off in ribbing.

Cuffs—From right side, with size 1 needles, pick up and k 50 (58-66-70) sts on sleeve edge—about 2 sts in every 3 rows. Work k 1, p 1 ribbing for 11 rows. Bind off.

FINISHING—Sew end of front border to adjoining shaped edge of neck border leaving an opening on right front for buttonhole. Work buttonhole. Block, see page 35. Sew underarm seams. Sew braid or bead trimming at inner edge of ribbed border around neck, fronts and back if desired.

Work even until armhole is same length as on back. Shape shoulder same as right shoulder of back. Continue band on remaining 19 sts until long enough to extend to center back of neck, end with 1 row of stripe. Break off, leaving end for weaving. Place sts on holder.

RIGHT FRONT—With size 1 needles and A, cast on 81 (85-89-93) sts loosely.

Row 1—wrong side—P 1, k 1 to within 19 sts of end, drop A, join B, with B, p 19 for front band.

Row 2—With B, k 9, slip 1 as to p, k 9; with A, work p 1, k 1 ribbing to end.

Row 3—**Buttonholes**—With A only, work ribbing to within 19 sts of end, p 3, bind off 3 sts, p until 7 sts from bind-off, bind off 3 sts, finish row.

Row 4—With A only, k 3, cast on 3 sts over buttonhole, k 3, slip 1, k 3, cast on 3 sts, k 3, work ribbing to end. Repeat buttonholes every 23rd and 24th row 4 times more, shaping to correspond to left front and working V-Neck decreases from right side as follows:

Work 19 sts of front band, slip, k and pass, finish row. Complete to correspond to left front working neckband until 1 row less than on left front. Place sts on holder.

SLEEVES—With size 1 needles and A, cast on 64 (66-68-70) sts loosely. Work k 1, p 1 ribbing for 3 ins., increasing 12 (14-16-18) sts evenly spaced across last row; 76 (80-84-88) sts.

With size 3 needles, work stockinette st increasing 1 st each side every ¼ in. 18 times; every 2nd row 9 times; every row 6 times; 142 (146-150-154) sts. Bind off 3 sts at beg. of each of next 38 (40-40-42) rows. Bind off 28 (26-30-28) sts.

FINISHING—Sew seams. Sew in sleeves, matching seams. Weave ends of border tog. matching pat. and sew border to back of neck. Fold under and hem facings. Finish buttonholes working through both thicknesses. Steam. see page 35.
